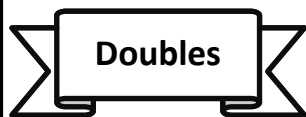

Deloris M. Webb Memorial Youth City Tournament Rules



Entry & Entry Fee

1. **Deadline for accepting entries will be November 5, 2022.**
2. Tournament entry fee will be \$20 per bowler per event. **Checks payable to "Indy USBC Association" or credit cards (4% processing fee added to credit card payments).**
3. Entry forms without payment or improperly completed will not be accepted.
4. Falsification on any entry will result in an automatic disqualification of the Youth Bowler or Bowlers involved.
5. Any changes to bowlers/bowler line up may only be changed by the Coach or Authorized Person in charge of submitting entry.

Eligibility

6. This tournament is open to all certified youth bowlers who are members of the Indy USBC Association.
7. Each Bowler must provide their Bowler Certification Card or proof of current USBC membership at time of check-in.
8. Each Coach or Authorized Person in Charge of submitting the entry form must provide League Standing Sheets for all bowler(s) as of Oct 29, 2022 to the Tournament Manager no later than Nov 5, 2022 or they must bring a current average verification/standing sheet at time of participation.

Averages

9. **Bowlers must use the higher average (of 12 games or more) from either the current 2022-23 season or the prior season as listed on Bowl.com - DO NOT list averages on the entry form for those bowlers who do not yet have 12 games for 2022-23.**
 - The Bowler, Coach, or Authorized Person in Charge must provide average confirmation (via a current league standing sheet or other average verification) to the Tournament Manager prior to or at the time of participation.
10. If no eligible average is available for either the current or prior season, the bowler will use an average of 190 with no handicap.

Participation

11. Bowlers may compete in the Team Event and/or the Singles/Doubles Event (**Singles is bowled first, then Doubles**).
12. Entry in All-Events is free and automatic for each Bowler who participates in both the Team and Singles/Doubles events.
13. No Singles-only or Doubles-only entries will be accepted.
14. Bowlers may compete more than once in the Team Event of this tournament. Bowlers may enter with as many teams as they bowl with in different Youth Leagues. However, not more than 2 Bowlers on the same 4-member team may compete together more than once or place in the prize list for position standings. When a Bowler competes more than once in the Team Event, his/her first appearance shall count toward his/her All-Events score.
15. Bowlers may not compete more than once in the Doubles Event.
16. Teams and Doubles partners may consist of boys, girls or a mix of both.
17. If there are less than 3 entries in any division, those Bowlers will be placed in the next lower division. If no lower division exists, those Bowlers will be placed in the next higher division.

Competition

18. Each Bowler must check in at the Tournament Center no later than 30 minutes prior to their scheduled bowling time and provide their Bowler Certification card or proof of current USBC membership.
19. Any Bowler who arrives late after his/her squad starts will receive 0 for every frame missed.
20. Once a Bowler has been removed from the roster due to emergency, he/she will receive a score of one tenth his/her average for each of the remaining frames in that game and no score for the remainder of the games in the series.
21. After a score has been passed to the official scorers by the Team Captain or individual Bowler, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious scoring or calculation error. All corrections must be made on the original score sheet.

Awards

22. Scholarships and trophies will be awarded based on the number of entries. At least one award will be presented for every ten entries. All Award Fees will be returned 100%.
23. Scholarships will be awarded for first place in All-Events (Handicap & Scratch) in each division (A, B, C) for Boys & Girls, based on number of entries.
24. A Bowler cannot win more than one All-Events title/scholarship. All-Events Actual will be regarded as the higher seed in the event of a tie. Coaches must apply for all Special Achievement and Honor Scores for their Bowlers that were bowled during this tournament.

Rules

25. **NO COACHES, PARENTS OR ELECTRONICS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE BOWLERS AREA.**
26. **New USBC Equipment Specification Rule – Bowling Balls - No balance holes will be permitted. All holes drilled must be used for gripping purposes on every delivery. No more than three (3) ounces of weight on any halves of the ball.**
27. **USBC Rule #18 - While bowling in USBC competition, a bowling ball CANNOT: (a) have the surface altered by the use of an abrasive, (b) be cleaned with any liquid substance or cleaning agent, or (c) have any foreign material on it including, but not limited to, powder, rosin, marker or paint. All bowling balls so altered or cleaned must be removed from the competition. Note: Should a foreign substance appear on the outer surface of a bowling ball which cannot be removed with a dry towel, an approved cleaner may be used with consent from a league or tournament officer.**
28. Tournament Director and the Tournament Committee will make all decisions and their decisions are final unless appealed to the USBC.
29. Any rules not covered herein will be covered by USBC playing rules and specifications until the end of the 2021-2022 bowling season.
30. This Tournament is certified by the USBC.
