Senior Tournament Rules

Please Read Carefully

- 1. Tournament is open to all certified members of the Indy USBC Association who are age 50 or older at the time of the tournament.
- 2. **USBC certification cards MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN**. All rules apply to both male and female entrants.
- 3. Tournament will be divided into five classes: Class A 70 years and older Class D 55 to 59 years

 Bowlers will be placed in a division based on their age on the first day of the tournament. Class C 60 to 64 years
- 4. ENTRY FEE is \$30 if received or postmarked by the entry deadline date of Friday, Mar 18th. Entries received after the deadline date of Mar 18th will be considered walk-in and must pay any remaining entry balance with <u>CASH or by Credit Card</u>. WALK-IN's will be accepted by <u>CASH & Credit Card</u> and must arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time. Walk-in Entry Fee is \$40.
- 5. Re-entry into the tournament is permitted. **Cost for re-entry is \$35** (\$30 entry fee + \$5 re-entry fee) **if received by Mar 18**th. Re-entry fee after that date is \$45..
- 6. Multiple entries are permitted. Bowlers may only cash one time highest 3-game series bowled will be awarded.
- 7. Entering Average:
 - a. Last year's highest INDY USBC yearbook average including summer averages from 2020-2021 will be used.
 - b. If there is no average from last year, the highest 2021-2022 season-ending USBC certified league average of 21 games or more will be used. If there is no current season-ending average, the bowler will bowl scratch.
 - c. Bowlers with neither of the above averages will use a 210 average.
 - d. USBC Rule 319d (reporting prize money) will not apply.
 - e. Rule 319c will apply to USBC entrants.
- 8. **Handicap** will be 100% of the difference between the bowlers average and 210.
- 9. Failure to use correct average shall disqualify scores, HOWEVER, corrections may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series. In accordance with USBC Rule 319a3, if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap, score will be disqualified unless a correction is made.) Prize winnings shall be based on submitted average if it is higher than the corrected average. Sport averages will only be converted and used if it is the only average available. Bowlers will bowl three games for scoring purposes.
- 10. Any scoring errors must be called to the attention of a tournament official immediately or within 24 hours of being bowled. Protests affecting eligibility or playing rules must be submitted/confirmed in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours and before the tournament prize payments are made.
- 11. <u>USBC Rule #18</u> While bowling in USBC competition, a bowling ball <u>CANNOT</u>: (a) have the surface altered by the use of an abrasive, (b) be cleaned with <u>ANY liquid substance or cleaning agent</u>, (c) have any foreign material on it including, but not limited to, powder, rosin, marker or paint. All bowling balls so altered or cleaned must be removed from the competition. Note: Should a foreign substance appear on the outer surface of a bowling ball which cannot be removed with a dry towel, an approved cleaner may be used with consent from a league or tournament officer. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Until further notice, USBC will temporarily <u>ALLOW</u> the use of isopropyl alcohol, aka rubbing alcohol, on the outer surface of the ball at any time during USBC certified Competitions.
- 12. All prizes will be returned 100% and awarded on a handicap basis only. First place awards will be presented for each handicap winner in each class for both men and women. Prize ratio will be 1 in 5.
- 13. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the Indy USBC Association, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees, if and when these entries shall be, through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule changes, or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by war, national emergency, or emergencies of causes relating thereto or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Indy USBC Association.
- 14. Any rules not covered herein will be covered by USBC playing rules and specifications until the end of the 2021-2022 bowling season.
